DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Mainly laying year rings with colour variation, sapwood allowed up to 35% of the surface. Knots up to 5 mm.

Oil: This floor should be oiled immediately after installation.

Colour change: Stained product - little colour change.

Packages may contain start and stop boards.
